# TEACHING ENGLISH IN EUROPE

The English teaching market in Europe is vast. Learning English has become more essential since 1993, when the EU was founded, making English a common language for business and education. Although there are many member countries of the EU, each country has its own hiring practices and visa rules for non-EU citizens. However, if you have EU citizenship, you will not need to apply separately for a work visa.
